Recital Rehearsal Information

- 1. All Rehearsals are closed to parents. All Dancers will be checked in and out at the front desk. It is important that all dancers are dropped off and picked up ON TIME!!!
- 2. No food is allowed at rehearsals. Please be sure to send labeled water with your dancer or \$1 to purchase cold water from the studio.
- 3. All dancers are required to have all proper dance shoes at all recital rehearsals. Shoe requirements are listed below in this packet.

Show Day Note

All end of semester tuition and fees must be paid before you will receive your costume or perform in the recital. All Dancers must arrive at the Powell Arena at building 13 near parking lot 4 by 6PM for check-in. During this time, we will be blocking routines on stage and taking a group picture. Slocomb Auditorium lobby doors will open at 6:45PM for merchandise purchases and pre-order pick-up. Auditorium doors will open at 7PM for seating. Slocomb Auditorium entrance is located to the left of where students will be dropped off. (Photo & Video references on the recital page of the website) The show will start promptly at 7:30PM, it's very important that all dancers arrive on time.

Please arrive in FULL COSTUME for your first performance, WITH MAKE-UP & HAIR DONE. We stick to a strict schedule so PLEASE DON'T BE LATE. Parents will not be allowed backstage. A detailed list of the show order is below.

Check In & Check Out

All students will be required to check in at the dancer entrance table located at the Powell Arena at building 13 near parking lot 4 to the right of the auditorium. All students will be checked out from the same door. A detailed photo and video is located on our recital page of the website for reference.

Costume Distribution: We will distribute costumes on Friday May 31st from 5PM-7PM. Any late arrival costumes due to sizing or availability will be distributed before recital.

Costume Storage & Care: Most costumes arrive wrinkled; using a steamer or hanging them in a steamy bathroom will remove most of the wrinkles. Do not iron your costumes. Even a cool iron can melt some of the fabrics. Make sure your dancer does not wear their costume prior to recital with the exception on trying it on for fitting purposes only. We will not be able to replace any damaged costumes. Please LABEL all costume pieces with your dancer's name as costumes changes happen quickly and clothing can get mixed up. It's easier to identify costumes with dancers' names in all pieces including shoes and dance tights.

Tights: All Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary & Lyrical classes must purchase skin tone convertible dance tights to wear under your costumes. Convertible Dance tights are suggested for quick costume changes. Convertible dance tights have a hole at the bottom of the foot so they can convert to footless tights. Tights can be purchased at any Dancewear store.

Recital Hair: All hair should be in a low pony tail with a side or middle part. This pony tail can be braided with straight braids, or straight hair only. (No curly pony tails or curly braids) Be sure to make sure all ponytails are secure and edges are slick and controlled.

Recital Makeup:

- **Eyes**: Natural tone eye shadow on the lid, Dark brown eye shadow in the crease, Light shadow under the eyebrow. Use black eye liner & black mascara, False lashes optional.
- **Cheeks**: Pink Blush
- **Lips**: Red Lip with purple liner and blend the two

Shoes: *Make sure you have the appropriate dance shoes for your dancers' performance.*
