Contest Categories:

There are four (4) scored categories in the contest. The maximum number of points that a participant can receive is 100 points. The categories and maximum points allotted are:




• 1. <u>Entrepreneurship (50 points)</u> – This is the participant's ability to participate in contest and to raise funds by way of sponsorship/ donation solicitations.




• 2. <u>Video Introduction- (20 points)</u> – Scoring based on contestant's ability to introduce herself to the public in a creative, energetic way. Videos must be creative and well edited as the videos will be presented at our Winter Dance Recital and on Social Media. Participants are scored on their ability to make a good first impression, professional appearance, articulation, social skills, correct grammar usage, and verbal skills.

3. <u>Tri-Fold Display- (20 points)</u> – This is the participant's special artistic expression. Scoring is based on overall appearance, originality and

- c) At least 7 or more facts are displayed on the poster.

2024 Miss XLD Scholarship Recipient Requirements

This Scholarship was created by Studio Owner & Company Director LaTrecia Mallet to not only award deserving dancers a full tuition scholarship for unlimited dance education at XLD but also an opportunity for dancers to showcase their leadership skills and make a difference amongst their peers and in the community.

*If recipient is a company member they must attend at *least* **3 Regional** Conventions/Competitions outside of our scheduled company events during the 2023-2024 season.

*If recipient is a company member they must attend our selected 2024 National Finals in Orlando, FL and Galveston, TX.

*Must participate in any events or performances hosted by Xtreme Level Dance & Fitness Studio.

*Attend all weekly training classes and rehearsals on a regular basis.

*Each XLD Queen will be required to assist assigned classes at the studio. Any classes when you are not assisting or demonstrating are expected to be taken with the same energy and focus as classes you assist.

*Perform a featured number in our Winter & Spring Recital.

*Miss XLD scholarship recipients will NOT be eligible for any other scholarships awarded at XLD for that calendar year.

*All Members must uphold a positive attitude & etiquette, free of gossip or taunting peers, dress appropriately, and be a positive role model for all dancers. Any violation could result in dismissal of program.

*Miss XLD scholarship recipients are allowed to participate in programs and clubs at their schools, church or community but must remember to fulfill the obligations of Miss XLD.

*You are an Ambassador of Xtreme Level Dance & Fitness Studio. You will be required to post at least 4 Social Media posts a month about the studio or of yourself at the studio. You will be required to repost all Social Media posts made by the studio. You will be required to post at least 2 Social Media posts when attending a competition or studio event weekend. As Miss XLD, you must uphold the reputation and moral standards of XLD. Anything deemed inappropriate by XLD Directors will be asked to be taken down immediately and may be grounds for dismissal. You must also uphold this standard at all times especially while wearing XLD attire.

*If XLD Directors feel a dancer is not keeping up with the standard of the program, a warning will first take place. If the dancer does not improve in a set time frame, dismissal may occur. A refund of any fees or sponsorships will not be issued.
